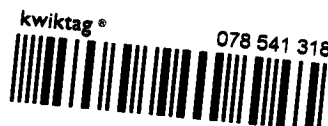

Respondent must pay the still unpaid costs imposed in Supreme Court order no. S147606 in equal installments with State Bar membership fees for the years 2011, 2012, 2013, 2014, and 2015. It is further ordered that if respondent fails to pay any installment within the time provided herein or as may be modified by this court pursuant to section 6086.10, subdivision (c), the remaining balance of the costs is due and enforceable both as provided in Business and Professions Code section 6140.7 and as a money judgment.


