
On December 10, 2010, Respondent filed a motion pursuant to rule 282 of the Rules of Procedure of the State Bar of California to extend the time for him to pay disciplinary costs. On December 29, 2010, the State Bar filed an opposition to that motion.

Respondent has demonstrated that hardship exists and that he is unable to pay the disciplinary costs on the schedule previously established by this court in its order of January 11, 2010. Accordingly, the time for Respondent to pay such costs is extended as follows:

Respondent must pay the still unpaid costs imposed in Supreme Court order no. S147606 in equal installments with State Bar membership fees for the years 2012, 2013, 2014, 2015 and 2016. It is further ordered that if Respondent fails to pay any installment within the time provided herein or as may be modified by this court pursuant to section 6086.10, subdivision (c), the remaining balance of the costs is due and enforceable both as provided in Business and Professions Code section 6140.7 and as a money judgment.


