TO ALL PARTIES AND COUNSEL IN THE ABOVE ENTITLED MATTER:

On November 24, 2010, the Supreme Court filed disciplinary order number S186375 (State Bar Court case numbers 00-O-13541 et al.) effective as of December 24, 2010. Pursuant to the order, respondent had to pay disciplinary costs of \$7,463.

On May 26, 2011, petitioner Paul Nelson Dane II, sought relief from or an extension of time to comply with the order assessing disciplinary costs based on financial hardship.

On June 7, 2011, Deputy Trial Counsel Mark Hartman of the Office of the Chief Trial Counsel of the State Bar of California (State Bar) filed a response. The State Bar does not oppose a four- year extension of time to pay costs.

Good cause appearing, the court **GRANTS** the motion and orders that petitioner pay one-fourth of his disciplinary costs in four annual installments of \$1,865.75 with his membership fees for each of the years 2012, 2013, 2014 and 2015.

The court further **ORDERS** that, if petitioner fails to pay any installment of disciplinary costs within the time provided herein or as may be modified by the State Bar Court pursuant to Business and Professions Code section 6086.10, subdivision (c), the remaining balance of the

costs is due and payable immediately unless relief has been granted under the Rules of Procedure of the State Bar of California. (Rules Proc. of State Bar, rule 5.134.) The payment of costs remains enforceable both as provided in Business and Professions Code section 6140.7 and as a money judgment.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
