**ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO
MODIFY CONDITIONS OF PROBATION
AND EXTENSION OF TIME**

On July 15, 2005, the State Bar of California, Office of Probation (OP), by and through Supervising Attorney Jayne Kim, filed a motion for modification of probation and extension of time, in the above captioned matter, pursuant to rules 321, 550 et seq., Rules of Procedure of the State Bar of California and rule 951, California Rules of Court. The motion also requested a telephonic status conference be held so that the parties may further address this issue with the court. Respondent did not file an opposition to the motion.

On August 9, 2005, a telephonic status conference was held. Respondent stipulated to the probation modifications and the extension of time as addressed in the OP's motion.

Accordingly, after a review of the papers on file, the Court orders that certain conditions of Respondent's probation be modified as set forth below:

(1) Respondent shall take and complete Ethics School by August 7, 2006, and provide satisfactory proof to the Office of Probation. Any previous compliance date for Ethics School shall be deleted.

(2) Within thirty (30) days from the effective date of the court's order, Respondent shall,



1 if she has not done so already:

- 2 (i) Report to the Lawyer's Assistance Program of the State Bar of California ("LAP")
3 for an evaluation regarding mental health issues;
4 (ii) Deliver a copy of this court's order to LAP;
5 (iii) Sign a written agreement with LAP to be evaluated;
6 (iv) Sign a waiver directing and authorizing LAP to timely notify the OP of her
7 compliance or noncompliance with the terms of her LAP evaluation agreement;
8 (v) Provide satisfactory evidence of compliance with her LAP evaluation agreement to
9 the OP with regularly scheduled quarterly reports.
10 (3) Thereafter, during the period of probation, Respondent shall:
11 (i) Comply with the terms and conditions of her LAP evaluation agreement;
12 (ii) Sign a LAP participation agreement at the conclusion of her evaluation by LAP and
13 sign a waiver directing and authorizing LAP to timely notify the OP of her compliance or
14 noncompliance with the terms of her LAP participation agreement;
15 (iii) Comply with the terms and conditions of her LAP participation agreement;
16 (iv) Report her compliance to the OP with each quarterly report.
17 (4) Respondent shall take and provide passage of the MPRE to the OP by August 7,

18 2006.


