TO ALL PARTIES AND COUNSEL IN THE ABOVE ENTITLED MATTER:

On March 12, 2010, petitioner DANIEL R. RAMIREZ (Petitioner) filed a motion for relief from the prior order to pay disciplinary costs. (Rules Proc. of State Bar, rule 282.) The motion includes a financial statement and a declaration from Petitioner, detailing his financial condition and the circumstances why an extension is being requested. The motion and its supporting papers show that Petitioner is disabled and now financially depends on his Social Security disability income of \$840 per month.

No opposition by the State Bar has been filed to the motion, and the time for it to do so has now elapsed.

Good cause appearing, the motion for relief is GRANTED. Petitioner is relieved, in whole, from the obligation to pay the remaining disciplinary costs previously assessed against him as part of his resignation from the State Bar while charges were pending.


