TO ALL PARTIES AND COUNSEL IN THE ABOVE ENTITLED MATTER:

On January 20, 2010, Kent Klokow (Klokow) filed a motion for relief from payment of disciplinary costs assessed against him by the Supreme Court in its September 28, 2000 order in case No. S091693. On February 2, 2010, the Office of the Chief Trial Counsel of the State Bar (State Bar) filed a response to Klokow's motion, stating its non-opposition to said motion.

In light of the facts set forth in Klokow's motion and the attachment thereto, and the financial declaration, which Klokow signed under penalty of perjury, the court finds the requisite good cause of financial hardship. (Rules Proc. of State Bar, rule 282(a).) The court also finds that under the circumstance Klokow requested relief as soon as practicable. (Rules Proc. of State Bar, rule 282(b).) Accordingly, Kent Klokow's motion for relief from costs is **GRANTED**.


