ORDER DELETING CERTAIN ITEMS FROM THE CERTIFICATE OF COSTS

TO ALL PARTIES AND COUNSEL IN THE ABOVE ENTITLED MATTER:

On December 15, 2010, respondent Patrick Earl Marshall challenged the propriety of including the cost of \$1,855 for transcription of State Bar Court hearing in the certificate of costs because a hearing record transcription was not required for his summary review request.

On December 17, 2010, Supervising Trial Counsel Donald Steedman of the Office of the Chief Trial Counsel of the State Bar filed a response, not only agreeing that the transcription charge be deleted, but also asking that the \$403.20 charge for audio recordings be deleted.

ACCORDINGLY, good cause appearing, the court hereby **GRANTS** the parties' requests and orders that a total of \$2,258.20 (\$1,855 + \$403.20) charge be deleted from the certificate of costs filed September 22, 2010. (Rules Proc. of State Bar, *new* rule 5.130.)
