On February 27, 2013, Respondent filed a motion seeking relief from the Supreme Court's prior order(s) assessing costs in this matter. In support of his motion, Respondent provided a financial statement and supporting documentation showing his present financial inability to pay the required costs. Among other things, Respondent asks that his obligation to pay costs be deferred so that he may be restored to active practice, thereby allowing him to generate the income required to pay the costs.

On March 13, 2013, the State Bar filed its response to the motion. Although the State Bar indicated that it objected to this court completely extinguishing Respondent's obligation to pay costs, it agreed that good cause has been demonstrated for some partial relief to be granted, including the granting of an extension of time for such costs to be paid.

On March 20, 2013, this court issued an order requiring the parties to meet and confer regarding an appropriate reduction of costs and a resulting installment payment plan. Both sides


have now presented to this court their positions in that session. The information provided indicates that the combined cost awards in the captioned matters totals \$22,076.23. In case nos. 01-O-04455, etc., costs total \$15,693.63. In case nos. 10-O-06417, etc., costs total \$6,382.60.

GOOD CAUSE having been shown, the costs in case nos. 01-O-04455, etc. are now reduced to \$6,000, and the costs in case nos. 10-O-06417, etc. are now reduced to \$3,000. Costs in each matter will now be paid in equal installments over the five billing cycles following the effective date of this order. More specifically, one-fifth of the disciplinary costs in case nos. 01-O-04455, etc. and one-fifth of the disciplinary costs in case nos. 10-O-06417, etc. are to be paid prior to February 1, 2014; one-fifth of the disciplinary costs in each matter is to be paid prior to February 1, 2015; one-fifth of the disciplinary costs in each matter is to be paid prior to February 1, 2016; one-fifth of the disciplinary costs in each matter is to be paid prior to February 1, 2017; and one-fifth of the disciplinary costs in each matter is to be paid prior to February 1, 2018.

If Respondent fails to pay any of the above installment payments more than 10 days after its due date without the prior written approval of the State Bar, the remaining unpaid balance of the costs is due immediately and is enforceable, both as provided in Business and Professions Code section 6140.7 and as a money judgment.

IT IS SO ORDERED.


