
ORDER MODIFYING CONDITIONS
OF PROBATION

Effective May 23, 2004, the Supreme Court adopted the discipline recommendation of the State Bar Court in its order approving the stipulation of the parties, filed December 18, 2003. However, by mistake, the State Bar Court's recommended discipline included compliance with criminal probation, when in fact, there was no underlying criminal matter. This error has been brought to the attention of the court by a stipulation of the parties to delete the subject requirement, filed on July 23, 2004.

Good cause appearing, the court hereby deletes from the probation conditions in this disciplinary matter the requirement of compliance with criminal probation. All other terms and conditions of probation are to remain in full force and effect.


