

Since respondent **GEORGE S. KELLNER, State Bar No. 111670**, has been convicted of violating Penal Code section 129 and Revenue and Taxation Code section 19706, felonies, under the authority of rule 951(a), California Rules of Court, it is ordered pursuant to Business and Professions Code section 6102 that respondent be suspended from the practice of law, effective April 9, 2005, pending final disposition of this proceeding. The review department reserves the issue of the moral turpitude classification of these crimes. It is further ordered that respondent comply with rule 955, California Rules of Court, and perform the acts specified in subdivisions (a) and (c) of that rule within 30 and 40 days, respectively, after the effective date of this suspension.
