**ORDER REGARDING RESPONDENT'S  
MOTION FOR RELIEF FROM COSTS  
AND FOR MODIFICATION OF  
PROBATION CONDITIONS**

On October 1, 2007, respondent Wayne Winrow filed a motion for relief from costs and for modification of probation and other conditions imposed by the California Supreme Court in its disciplinary order no. S142778, filed on June 27, 2006.<sup>1</sup> On October 10, 2007, the Office of the Chief Trial Counsel and the Office of Probation, by Susan I. Kagan and Terrie Goldade, respectively, filed opposition thereto.

On the grounds of financial hardship caused by family health and other unfortunate circumstances that occurred between March and August of 2006 and October, 2006 and May, 2007, respondent asks for relief from or more time to:

- (1) Complete Ethics School, which was due to be completed by July 27, 2007;
- (2) File, with his quarterly reports, proof of mental health treatment received twice a month;
- (3) Complete the Multistate Professional Responsibility Examination (MPRE); and
- (4) Pay disciplinary costs.

Having considered the parties' contentions and good cause appearing under the particular circumstances surrounding these requests (i.e., the unfortunate family events and resulting financial hardship), the court GRANTS and DENIES the requests as follows as consistent with the protection

of the public and the successful rehabilitation of respondent (rule 550, Rules Proc. of State Bar):

(1) Respondent is allowed three months from the date of service of this order to complete Ethics School as previously ordered;


(2) Proof of mental health treatment: Respondent is allowed 15 days from the date of service of this order to submit to the Office of Probation all outstanding proof of mental health treatment. The request for modification of this probation condition is otherwise DENIED and respondent is to comply with it as originally ordered;

(3) The request for an extension of time to complete the MPRE is not ripe because respondent was ordered to complete it within one year or during the period of his actual suspension, whichever is longer, and he remains actually suspended<sup>2</sup>; and

(4) Respondent must pay the costs imposed in Supreme Court order no. S142778, filed on June 27, 2006, in equal installments with State Bar membership fees for the years 2009 and 2010. It is further ordered that if respondent fails to pay any installment within the time provided herein or as may be modified by the State Bar Court pursuant to section 6086.10, subdivision (c), the remaining balance of the costs is due and enforceable both as provided in Business and Professions Code section 6140.7 and as a money judgment.

IT IS SO ORDERED.


