<u>ORDER</u> TRANSFERRING MEMBER TO ACTIVE STATUS

TO ALL PARTIES AND COUNSEL IN THE ABOVE ENTITLED MATTER:

On July 13, 2010, petitioner was enrolled as an inactive member of the State Bar for sixty days under Business and Professions Code section 6233.¹

Petitioner now seeks an order that will allow him to return to active membership status enrollment. Petitioner supports his petition with evidence that he has not engaged in the unauthorized practice of law since the beginning of his suspension on July 13, 2010, that he has been in full compliance with the requirements of his enrollment in the ADP.

The court having considered the petition finds good cause to grant the petition. The Court finds, by clear and convincing evidence, that there is no longer a basis for petitioner's involuntary inactive enrollment pursuant to section 6233.

ACCORDINGLY, it is ordered that the petition for transfer to active membership status is **GRANTED**. It is further ordered that petitioner's inactive enrollment pursuant to section 6233 is hereby terminated and he is entitled to resume the practice of law in this state on September 13, 2010.
