This matter is before the court on respondent MICHAEL THOMAS MORRISSEY'S June 18, 2012 motion for extension of time to take and pass the Multistate Professional Responsibility Examination (MPRE) under the Supreme Court's May 26, 2011 order in case number S191620 (State Bar Court case number 03-C-03823-PEM, etc.). In addition, the matter is before the court on respondent's June 25, 2012 motion to modify the probation imposed on him under that same Supreme Court order by extending the time in which respondent must take and successfully complete the State Bar's Ethics School.

On June 25, 2012, the State Bar's Office of Probation filed a response to respondent's motion to extend the time to take and pass the MPRE stating that the Office of Probation does not oppose respondent's request for extension of time to provide proof of his passage of the August 2012 MPRE. On June 29, 2012, the Office of Probation filed an opposition to respondent's motion to modify probation.

ORDER

Good cause having been shown, the court orders that respondent's June 18, 2012 motion for extension of time to take and pass the MPRE is **GRANTED** and that the time in which

respondent must take and pass the MPRE and provide proof of his passage to the Office of Probation is **EXTENDED** until December 22, 2012. (Cal. Rules of Court, rule 9.10(b); Rules Proc. of State Bar, rule 5.161(A)(2).) The court further orders, for good cause shown, that respondent's June 25, 2012 motion to modify probation is **GRANTED** and that the time in which respondent must attend and successfully complete the State Bar's Ethics School is also **EXTENDED** until December 22, 2012. (Cal. Rules of Court, rule 9.10(c)(2); Rules Proc. of State Bar, rule 5.161(A)(1).)


