**SECOND AMENDED ORDER GRANTING  
MOTIONS FOR EXTENSION OF TIME  
TO PAY COSTS AND TO EXTEND  
PROBATION IN ORDER TO PAY  
RESTITUTION**

This order supercedes the December 7 and 10, 2007 orders, and is effective, *nunc pro tunc*, as of November 19, 2007.

On November 19, 2007, respondent Zakeya Leona Brookins, filed a motion to extend her probation in order to pay restitution and a motion to extend the time to pay costs arising out of disciplinary proceedings. On December 5, 2007, respondent filed a supplemental declaration in support of her motion to extend probation.

On November 21, 2007, the Office of the Chief Trial Counsel of the State Bar of California, by Deputy Trial Counsel Eli D. Morgenstern, filed a response to the motion to extend time to pay costs, indicating no opposition to an extension to pay up to and including June 15, 2008. On November 29, 2007, the Office of Probation of the State Bar of California, by Supervising Trial Counsel Terrie Goldade, filed a response, indicating no opposition to extending probation.

On December 7, 2007, this court ruled on the motions. Inadvertently, the court omitted a portion of the intended order. On December 10, 2007, the court issued an amended order that inadvertently did not extend the probation for three years, as intended.

**GOOD CAUSE APPEARING THEREFOR**, it is recommended that the period of respondent's probation is extended by an additional three years, and that respondent's time for paying disciplinary costs for each of the following years is ordered extended as set forth below:

**IT IS FURTHER RECOMMENDED** that respondent is to make minimum payments of at least \$100 per month, payable first to the individual payees to whom she owes restitution, and then, when such individual payees are fully paid, to the Client Security Fund.

Service of this order shall be upon both the Office of the Chief Trial Counsel and the Office of Probation of the State Bar of California.

It is ordered that the record in this matter be transmitted forthwith to the California Supreme Court.


