On January 20, 2012, respondent filed a motion to extend time to take and pass the MPRE and to modify the terms of his probation as to restitution. On January 2, 2012, the Office of Probation of the State Bar California, by Supervising Attorney Terrie Goldade, filed opposition to portions of the motion.

GOOD CAUSE APPEARING THEREFOR, respondent's motion for an extension of time to take and pass the MPRE is **GRANTED**. The time within which respondent must provide proof of passage of the MPRE is extended to **May 2, 2012**.

Respondent also seeks to modify his probation conditions as to the first restitution payment of \$100,000 due on or before February 10, 2012. Respondent has failed, however, to attach a financial declaration to his motion. In Exhibit 6, respondent has attached a printout setting forth his Income "Average 2011-0 to 3 months". Respondent, however, has not declared the printout to be true under penalty of perjury and has not stated how or why he has rounded numbers on certain entries. As such, **NO GOOD CAUSE APPEARING THEREFOR**, this

portion of the motion is **DENIED** without prejudice to being refiled in a form consistent with this order.


