

On December 20, 2012, this court issued an order suspending respondent from the practice of law in this state effective January 14, 2013, pending proof of passage, since he had not passed the Multistate Professional Responsibility Examination (MPRE) within the time prescribed in the Supreme Court order filed October 25, 2011. On December 26, 2012, respondent filed a motion for an order extending time to take the MPRE. Also, on December 26, 2012, the State Bar filed its opposition to the motion.

Finding no good cause, respondent's motion to extend the time to take the MPRE is denied. However, the previously ordered suspension date is modified, and respondent will be suspended from the practice of law in this state effective March 8, 2013, pending proof of passage of the MPRE.
