

INACTIVE ENROLLMENT****INTRODUCTION**

On August 12, 2004, Award Debtor Michael Thomas Dell'Osso ("Dell Osso") filed a motion to terminate his inactive enrollment pursuant to rule 710 of the Rules of the Procedure of the State Bar. Dell'Osso submitted proof that he paid the arbitration award to Charles Hall in full, including interest and the penalties assessed as a result of his failure to comply with the award. On August 16, 2004, the Mandatory Fee Arbitration Program of the State Bar ("State Bar") filed its non-opposition to Dell' Osso motion based on satisfactory proof of payment.

Good cause having been shown, the motion to terminate the inactive enrollment is hereby GRANTED. It is further ordered that Dell' Osso's inactive enrollment be terminated and that he be transferred to active enrollment immediately. (Bus. & Prof. Code, section 6203(d)(4); Rules Proc. of State Bar, rule 710.)
