ORDER TERMINATING INVOLUNTARY INACTIVE ENROLLMENT

## INTRODUCTION

On August 12, 2004, Award Debtor Michael Thomas Dell'Osso ("Dell Osso") filed a motion to terminate his inactive enrollment pursuant to rule 710 of the Rules of the Procedure of the State Bar.
