On the court's own motion, the decision filed on November 19, 2010, is modified as follows:

1. At page 6, paragraph 1, the actual suspension should be two years and until compliance with standard 1.4(c)(ii), Rules Proc. of State Bar, tit. IV, Stds. for Atty. Sanctions for Prof. Misconduct, and not one year; and
2. At page 8, in the second full paragraph "two-year" is replaced by "three-year."

The parties have 15 days to object to these modifications. If no objection is timely filed, IT IS ORDERED that the record in this matter be transmitted to the California Supreme Court forthwith.


