**Introduction**

This matter is before the court on respondent MATTHEW A. BROMUND's July 2, 2010, motion for relief from discipline costs, or in the alternative, an extension of time to pay disciplinary costs. The State Bar of California ("State Bar") filed a response in non-opposition to an extension of time to pay discipline costs but opposed complete relief from the costs, on July 16, 2010. Respondent is representing herself in this matter. The State Bar is represented by Deputy Trial Counsel Mia Ellis.

After a careful review of the respondent's motion and the response, the court GRANTS the motion to extend time to pay discipline costs, good cause having been shown and DENIES respondent's motion for complete relief from the costs., no good cause having been shown. Accordingly, respondents must pay the ordered discipline costs equally over a three year period, beginning in 2011.

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The court's order is effective upon filing.


