ORDER RE DISCIPLINARY COSTS

TO ALL PARTIES AND COUNSEL IN THE ABOVE ENTITLED MATTER:

On January 15, 2009, petitioner **Richter Kong** through his counsel Vicki H. Young of the Law Offices of Ephraim Margolin sought an extension of time to comply with the order assessing disciplinary costs based on financial hardship. (Rules Proc. of State Bar, rule 282.) Petitioner proposes to pay the costs of \$6,883.96 on August 8, 2013.

On February 17, 2009, Deputy Trial Counsel Manuel Jimenez of the Office of the Chief Trial Counsel of the State Bar of California (State Bar) filed a response. The State Bar opposes an extension of time to make any payment until 2013. But it does not oppose a payment plan in which petitioner pays four equal installments due over the next four years.

In view of petitioner's financial hardship and good cause appearing, the court orders that respondent's time during which to pay the disciplinary costs of \$6,883.96 be extended to four

equal installments: one-fourth of said costs be paid with membership fees for the years 2010, 2011, 2012 and 2013. It is further ordered that if respondent fails to pay any installment within the time provided herein or as may be modified by the State Bar Court pursuant to Business and Professions Code section 6086.10, subdivision (c), the remaining balance of the costs is due and enforceable both as provided in Business and Professions Code section 6140.7 and as a money judgment.

IT IS SO ORDERED.


