
On July 19, 2010, Respondent Joe Mendivel (Respondent) and the State Bar filed a stipulation for relief from the Supreme Court's prior order assessing costs in this matter.

The parties having stipulated thereto and good cause having been shown, such costs will now be paid in equal installments over the three billing cycles following the effective date of this order. More specifically, one-third of the disciplinary costs, namely \$2,533.21, are to be paid prior to February 1, 2011; one-third of the costs, namely \$2,533.21, are to be paid prior to February 1, 2012; and one-third of the costs, namely \$2,533.21, are to be paid prior to February 1, 2013.

If Respondent fails to pay any of the above installment payment more than 10 days after its due date without the prior written approval of the State Bar, the remaining unpaid balance of the costs is due immediately and is enforceable both as provided in Business and Professions Code section 6140.7 and as a money judgment.


