MODIFICATION ORDER**

The Order Approving Stipulation Re Facts, Conclusions of Law and Disposition ("stipulation") filed on November 28, 2006, is hereby MODIFIED, sua sponte, to include the following modifications:

1. On page 4 of the stipulation, an "x" is inserted in the box next to paragraph D.(1)(a).
2. On page 5 of the stipulation, the "XX" in the box next to paragraph E.(1) is deleted, as the recommended period of actual disciplinary suspension in this matter is less than two years. (See Rules Proc. of State Bar, tit. IV, Stds. for Atty. Sanctions for Prof. Misconduct, standard 1.4(c)(ii).)
3. On page 8 of the stipulation, under Count Five, third paragraph, line 2, "willful" is inserted between "in" and "violation".

Any objection to this modification order must be filed within 15 days of its service. If no timely objection is filed, the stipulation as modified remains approved, and a staff member of the State Bar Court is directed to transmit the record in this matter to the Supreme Court without further delay.
