ORDER

No good cause shown, respondent's request to stay interim suspension is denied. Since respondent TERRY N. CHRISTENSEN has been convicted of conspiracy to intercept wire communications (18 U.S.C. §§ 371 and 2511(1)(a)) and aiding and abetting the interception of wire communications (18 U.S.C. §§ 2 and 2511(1)(a)), under the authority of rule 9.10(a), California Rules of Court, it is ordered pursuant to Business and Professions Code section 6102 that respondent be suspended from the practice of law, effective November 24, 2008, pending final disposition of this proceeding. It is further ordered that respondent comply with rule 9.20, California Rules of Court, and perform the acts specified in subdivisions (a) and (c) of that rule within 30 and 40 days, respectively, after the effective date of this suspension.

The court defers the moral turpitude classification of the crimes until finality of the convictions.
