By order filed March 26, 2008, the Supreme Court vacated its prior order (filed February 21, 2008) accepting Leslie J. Sherman's resignation with disciplinary charges pending. Accordingly, this court's order filed March 18, 2008, dismissing this case is hereby vacated.

The interim suspension imposed by this court's order filed August 31, 2007, is reinstated, effective the date this order is filed. The court has not yet received evidence showing that Sherman's conviction is final.
