

ORDER

Good cause shown, respondent's motion to vacate interim suspension filed September 25, 2009, is granted in part. The interim suspension imposed by our order filed October 30, 2008, is stayed, effective upon the filing of this order, pending final resolution of this matter. (Bus. & Prof. Code, §6102, subd. (a); Cal. Rules of Court, rule 9.10(a).)

Finding no good cause, the court denies without prejudice the State Bar's request to impose interim remedies. The State Bar may monitor respondent's compliance with his criminal probation conditions, and if circumstances warrant, may file a subsequent motion for interim remedies or to lift the stay of interim suspension.
