According to the plea agreement and verdict forms, Respondent was convicted by jury verdict on counts 5 and  
6 on July 28, 2008, and pled guilty to amended count 3 and new count 7 on July 29, 2008, and the court  
dismissed counts 1, 2, and 4. On that date, the Court sentenced Respondent on counts 5, 6 and 7 to 3 years  
of formal probation but stayed the sentencing on count 3 (the felony count).


