

Since respondent **THOMAS D. GRABINSKI**, State Bar number 147442, has been convicted of violating Arizona Revised Statute section 13-2310, a felony involving moral turpitude, and Arizona Revised Statute section 13-2312, a felony, under the authority of rule 9.10(a) of the California Rules of Court, it is ordered pursuant to Business and Professions Code section 6102 that respondent be suspended from the practice of law, effective February 8, 2008, pending final disposition of this proceeding. It is further ordered that respondent comply with rule 9.20 of the California Rules of Court and perform the acts specified in paragraphs (a) and (c) of that rule within 30 and 40 days, respectively, after the effective date of this suspension.

The review department reserves the issue of the moral turpitude classification of respondent's violation of Arizona Revised Statute section 13-2312. The parties are directed to file briefs within 20 days of the service of this order addressing the issue of whether or not respondent's violation involves moral turpitude per se.
