MODIFICATION ORDER

The Order Approving Stipulation Re Facts, Conclusions of Law and Disposition ("stipulation") filed on March 16, 2007, is hereby MODIFIED, sua sponte, to include the following modifications:

1. On page 2 of the stipulation, the following language is inserted at paragraph A.(8):


If respondent fails to pay any installment within the time provided herein or as may be modified by the State Bar Court under Bus. & Prof. Code, § 6086.10, subdivision (c) (see Rules Proc. of State Bar, rules 282 & 284), the remaining balance of the costs is due and payable immediately and is enforceable as provided in Bus. & Prof. Code, § 6140.7 and as a money judgment unless relief is granted under the Rules Proc. of State Bar. (See Rules Proc. of State Bar, rule 286.)
2. On page 5 of the stipulation, the "X" in the box next to paragraph E.(1) requiring conditional compliance with standard 1.4(c)(ii) is deleted, as the stipulation already provides that respondent will remain on actual suspension until he pays specified restitution and shows proof satisfactory to the State Bar Court of rehabilitation, present fitness to practice, and present learning and ability in the law pursuant to standard 1.4(c)(ii).

Any objection to this modification order must be filed within 15 days of its service. If no timely objection is filed, the stipulation as modified remains approved, and a staff member of the



State Bar Court is directed to transmit the record in this matter to the Supreme Court without further delay.


