MODIFICATION ORDER

The stipulated facts and disposition and order approving same filed on August 22, 2006, are modified as follows:

1. On page 2, paragraph A.(8),
DELETE: "Costs to be paid in equal amounts prior to February 1 for the following billing-cycles following the effective date of the Disciplinary Order: 2007, 2008, 2009."
REPLACE with: "One-third of costs will be paid with membership fees for the next three billing cycles following the effective date of the Supreme Court disciplinary order."
2. On page 5 of the stipulation,
DELETE: The "x" in the box next to paragraph E.(1), which states "[i]f Respondent is actually suspended for two years or more, he/she must remain actually suspended until he/she proves to the State Bar Court his/her rehabilitation, fitness to practice, and learning and ability in general law, pursuant to standard 1.4(c)(ii), Standards for Professional Misconduct."

The parties have 15 days from the date of service of this order to file any objections thereto. If no objections are timely filed, the stipulation as modified remains approved, and the Clerk of the



State Bar Court is ordered to transmit the record in this matter to the California Supreme Court without further delay.
