On February 10, 2010, the parties in the above-entitled matter submitted for consideration and approval a Stipulation Re Facts, Conclusions of Law and Disposition (Stipulation) to the Honorable Richard A. Platel, the settlement judge in this matter. The Stipulation provided that respondent would be disbarred in this matter.

Having been made aware of Judge Platel's order of February 11, 2010, approving the stipulation, as modified, and recommending to the Supreme Court that respondent be disbarred, the court now issues the following order pursuant to Business and Professions Code section 6007, subdivision (c)(4) and rule 220(c) of the Rules of Procedure of the State Bar of California.

Respondent Ira David Hazelkorn is ordered transferred to involuntary inactive status pursuant to Business and Professions Code section 6007, subdivision (c)(4). Respondent's inactive enrollment will be effective three (3) days after this order is served by mail and will terminate upon the effective date of the Supreme Court's order imposing discipline herein, as



provided for by rule 490(b) of the Rules of Procedure of the State Bar of California, or as otherwise ordered by the Supreme Court pursuant to its plenary jurisdiction.
