ORDER REGARDING MOTION FOR RECONSIDERATION

On March 22, 2007, the Office of the Chief Trial Counsel of the State Bar of California (State Bar), by Paul T. O'Brien, filed a motion for reconsideration of the court's March 15, 2007, decision in the captioned default matter.

After considering the evidence and the law, the court GRANTS the motion in part and ORDERS that: (1) the decision filed on March 15, 2007, be vacated; (2) the submission date of the case be vacated; (3) the record be reopened to allow the court to judicially notice a local federal court rule and make findings and legal conclusions in accordance thereto, among other things; and (4) the matter be submitted as of the date this order is filed.
