This matter is before the court on its own motion.

The July 16, 2012 order of the Honorable Richard A. Platel regarding respondent Eugene Wellington Matthews's motion to modify terms of probation and to extend time to pay costs and other monies in the above-captioned matters is hereby modified as follows:

On page 2 of the July 16, 2012 order, the language at lines 1-3 pertaining to respondent's request to extend the time to pay costs in case No. 06-O-12121 is deleted, and in its place is inserted the following language:

Respondent's motion to extend the time to pay costs is GRANTED, good cause having been shown. Accordingly, one-third of the costs owed must be paid with respondent's membership fees for each of the years 2013, 2014, and 2015. If respondent fails to pay any installment as set forth above, or as may hereafter be modified by the court, the remaining balance is due and payable immediately.

Similarly, on page 2 of the July 16, 2012 order, the language at lines 7-9 pertaining to respondent's request to extend the time to pay costs in case No. 08-O-12594 is deleted, and in its place is inserted the following language:

Respondent's motion to extend the time to pay costs is GRANTED, good cause having been shown. Accordingly, one-third of the costs owed must be paid with respondent's membership fees for each of the years 2013, 2014, and 2015. If respondent fails to pay any installment as set forth above, or as may hereafter be modified by the court, the remaining balance is due and payable immediately.

In all other respects, the July 16, 2012 order remains unchanged.


