STIPULATION

Respondent Stuart I. Folinsky, in pro per, and the Office Of The Chief Trial Counsel, State Bar Of California ("State Bar"), by Senior Trial Counsel Charles A. Murray, hereby stipulate on grounds of hardship, special circumstances, or other good cause, to modify the terms of Respondent's obligation to pay disciplinary costs, as follows:

The current order of the Supreme Court is that Respondent pay the disciplinary costs assessed in the above-captioned matters, in full, with his membership fees for the year 2012. Respondent's membership fees were due February 1, 2012, and thus, his disciplinary costs in the above-captioned matters were also due February 1, 2012.

The parties stipulate to modify the terms of Respondent's payment disciplinary costs in the above-captioned matters, as follows:

Respondent shall pay one-third of these costs on or before March 31, 2012;

Respondent shall pay the remaining balance of these costs with his membership fees for the year 2013.

1 If Respondent fails to pay the costs due on or before March 31, 2012 or if he fails to pay
2 the entire remaining balance with his membership fees for the year 2013, all costs shall be
3 immediately due and payable and enforceable both as provided in Business and Professions
4 Code section 6140.7 and as a money judgment.

5 All other terms and conditions of the Supreme Court's disciplinary order in the above-
6 captioned matters shall remain in full force and effect.


7 This modification is requested by the parties pursuant to rule 5.132 of the Rules of
8 Procedure of the State Bar of California.

9 The parties request the Court make this order nunc pro tunc to January 31, 2012.


