By motion filed June 14, 2010, petitioner **Kevin Joseph Frank** requested the court to modify his substance abuse probation conditions, as ordered by the Supreme Court in S119102.

GOOD CAUSE HAVING BEEN SHOWN, petitioner's motion to modify his probation conditions in S119102 is **GRANTED, in part, and DENIED, in part**, such that (1) "and/or drugs" is deleted from petitioner's probation condition; (2) that petitioner should be tested for ethyl glucuronide (EtG - alcohol) every other month, instead of on a monthly basis; and (3) the condition for good cause random testing remains.


