

TO ALL PARTIES AND COUNSEL IN THE ABOVE ENTITLED MATTER:

On March 12, 2013, respondent Mark Henry Williams asked for an extension of time within which to complete his restitution payments and to pay disciplinary costs in this matter based on financial hardship. (Supreme Court order No. S177629, effective February 12, 2010.)

Assistant Chief Trial Dane C. Dauphine of the Office of the Chief Trial Counsel of the State Bar of California and Supervising Attorney Terrie Goldade of the Office of Probation filed their respective responses, proposing an installment payment plan for both restitution and disciplinary costs.

GOOD CAUSE APPEARING, respondent's motion for modification of probation and for extension of time to pay disciplinary costs is **GRANTED** as follows:

A. Order Modifying Probation Condition (Restitution)

The court hereby ORDERS that the probation condition of restitution be modified, such that respondent must pay restitution to:

1. **Araceli Pineda** (or the Client Security Fund, if it has already paid or if respondent could not locate Araceli Pineda's whereabouts) in the amount of \$4,000, plus ten percent (10%) interest per annum, accruing from April 24, 2006, pursuant to the following payment schedule: Respondent must pay monthly installment payments of \$200 to Araceli Pineda or the CSF, as applicable, and provide satisfactory proof of payment to the Office of Probation with each quarterly probation report, or as otherwise directed by the Office of Probation.

Respondent's monthly restitution payment begins on or before May 1, 2013.

On or before January 1, 2014, respondent must make any necessary final payment(s) in order to complete the payment of restitution, including interest, in full.

B. Order re Disciplinary Costs

Respondent must pay the disciplinary costs with his membership fees for the year 2014. If respondent fails to pay any installment within the time provided herein or as may be modified by the State Bar Court pursuant to Business and Professions Code section 6086.10, subdivision (c), the remaining balance of the costs is due and enforceable both as provided in Business and Professions Code section 6140.7 and as a money judgment.

IT IS SO ORDERED.


