TO ALL PARTIES AND COUNSEL IN THE ABOVE ENTITLED MATTER:

On December 10, 2007, respondent requested to be enrolled as an inactive member in the State Bar for 60 days under Business and Professions Code section 6233.¹

Based upon respondent's request to be enrolled as an inactive member and his acceptance into the State Bar Court's Alternative Discipline Program (ADP) on September 4, 2007, the Court granted respondent's request.

Petitioner now seeks an order that will allow him to return to active membership status enrollment. Petitioner supports his petition with evidence that he has not engaged in the unauthorized practice of law since the beginning of his suspension on December 11, 2007 and that he is in full compliance with the requirements of his enrollment in the ADP.

The Court having considered the petition and declaration finds good cause to grant the petition. The Court finds, by clear and convincing evidence, that there is no longer a basis for petitioner's involuntary inactive enrollment pursuant to section 6233.

ACCORDINGLY, it is ordered that the petition for transfer to active membership status is **GRANTED**. It is further ordered that petitioner's inactive enrollment pursuant to section 6233 is hereby terminated and he shall be entitled to resume the practice of law in this state on January 29, 2009.
