
**TO ALL PARTIES AND COUNSEL IN THE ABOVE ENTITLED MATTER:**

Having read and considered the Respondent's Motion for Extension of Time to take and pass the Multistate Professional Responsibility Examination (MPRE), filed on April 9, 2010, and the Office of Probation's opposition thereto, filed on April 13, 2010, the court finds good cause for the extension of Respondent's probation and the time during which he may take, pass, and provide proof of passage of the MPRE.

Accordingly, the motion is GRANTED, in part. It is hereby ordered that Respondent's probation is extended and he shall have until 10 days after the results of the August 2010 MPRE examination are released to submit to the Office of Probation proof of successful completion of that examination. Respondent's request that the time during which he may take and pass the MPRE be extended until May 2011 is DENIED. That denial is without prejudice to Respondent filing a subsequent motion in the event he fails the August 2010 MPRE.

IT IS SO ORDERED.


