**ORDER GRANTING, IN PART, MOTION  
FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO PAY  
DISCIPLINARY COSTS**

On December 3, 2010, respondent, Louis G. Fazzi, filed a motion for relief from or extension of time to pay disciplinary costs. With his motion, respondent filed a financial declaration. On December 14, 2010, the Office of the Chief Trial Counsel of the State Bar of California, by Deputy Trial Counsel Michael J. Glass, filed a responsive pleading to the motion, indicating opposition to full relief, but agreement to an alternative payment plan. On December 20, 2010, respondent filed a reply brief.

The court finds no good cause to provide full relief from the outstanding disciplinary costs. However, the court does find good cause to extend the payment over three years. Therefore, respondent must make three equal payments of one-third each of the total amount of disciplinary costs outstanding, commencing on March 1, 2011. Thereafter, the remaining two payments will be added to and paid along with respondent's annual State Bar dues for the years


