On February 6, 2012, petitioner **Christina Johnson** filed a motion seeking to be relieved from paying disciplinary costs or an extension of time to pay the disciplinary costs owed in the above-listed matter. Petitioner's motion was based on financial hardship. On February 8, 2012, the Office of the Chief Trial Counsel of the State Bar of California filed a response to the motion.

After consideration of the parties' moving papers, petitioner's motion for extension of time to comply with the order to pay disciplinary costs is **GRANTED**. The court orders that petitioner's time to pay the remaining disciplinary costs associated with case no. 06-O-15337 be extended. Respondent must pay one-fifth of her disciplinary costs along with her State Bar membership fees over the next five years (2013, 2014, 2015, 2016 and 2017). The payment of costs remains enforceable both as provided in Business and Professions Code section 6140.7 and as a money judgment.
