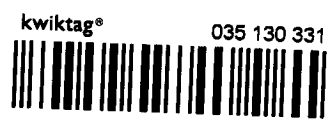
1. On page 4 of the stipulation, the "X" in the box next to paragraph D.(3)(a)(ii) is deleted.
