ORDER AMENDING ORDER GRANTING
MOTION TO REVOKE PROBATION AND
FOR INVOLUNTARY INACTIVE
ENROLLMENT

The court's Order Granting Motion to Revoke Probation and for Involuntary Inactive Enrollment ("order") filed on December 4, 2006, is hereby AMENDED, sua sponte, as follows:

1. On page 4 of the order, under the heading "Aggravation," line 2, "September 28, 2005" is deleted, and in its place is inserted "January 20, 2006."
2. On page 5 of the order, line 1 at the top of the page, insert "on conditions including that he be actually suspended for 30 days" after "years."

The amendments ordered are clerical corrections. Accordingly, the time for filing a motion to reopen the record, for a new trial and/or for reconsideration of the court's December 4, 2006, Order Granting Motion to Revoke Probation and for Involuntary Inactive Enrollment under rules 222, 223 and/or 224, respectively, of the Rules of Procedure of the State Bar of California and the time for filing a request for review of the Order Granting Motion to Revoke Probation and for Involuntary Inactive Enrollment under rule 301 of the Rules of Procedure must be calculated from December 4, 2006, the date the order was served on the parties.


