Since respondent Won Sok Lee, State Bar Number 199957, has been convicted of felony violations of 18 United States Code sections 371 (1341/1343) (conspiracy to commit mail fraud and wire fraud) and 1343 (wire fraud), crimes involving moral turpitude, under the authority of rule 9.10(a), California Rules of Court, it is ordered pursuant to Business and Professions Code section 6102 that respondent be suspended from the practice of law effective September 10, 2010, pending final disposition of this proceeding. It is also ordered that respondent comply with rule 9.20, California Rules of Court, and perform the acts specified in subdivisions (a) and (c) of that rule within 30 and 40 days, respectively, after the effective date of this suspension.


