On December 28, 2009, respondent **Richard E. Oriakhi** filed a motion for extension of time to take and pass the Multistate Professional Responsibility Examination ("MPRE"). On January 8, 2010, Office of Probation Supervising Attorney Terrie Goldade filed a response. In its response, the Office of Probation did not object to the extension of time for respondent to take and pass the MPRE, but requested that such an extension be limited to two weeks after the results of the examination are released.¹
