**ORDER GRANTING RESPONDENT'S
MOTION FOR MODIFICATION OF
PAYEE ON RESTITUTION ORDER**

Introduction

This matter is before the court on respondent **LAWRENCE R. YOUNG**'s November 29, 2011, motion modification of payee on restitution order. The State Bar of California ("State Bar") filed a response in non-opposition on December 6, 2011. The State Bar Court Review Department issued an order on December 1, 2011, referring this matter to the Hearing Department for ruling. Respondent is representing himself in this matter. The State Bar is represented by Supervising Attorney Terri Goldade.

After a careful review of the respondent's motion and the response, the court **GRANTS** the motion, good cause having been shown. Accordingly, the court modifies the original restitution order in the above captioned matter as follows:

The restitution order naming Richard Dominquez as entitled to restitution is deleted.

The following language will be added to the restitution order:

"Restitution to Sarah Rosales in the amount of \$10,000, plus interest in the amount of 10% per annum accruing from April 1, 2010, pursuant

to the following payment schedule:

“A minimum of \$200.00 per month for the first five (5) months following the effective date of discipline , proof to be shown quarterly commencing July 10, 2011.

A minimum payment of \$500.00 per month to be paid on the first of each month thereafter until paid in full.”


