On June 22, 2016, respondent filed a motion in this matter, in which he requests this court to modify the January 7, 2016, order previously issued in this case. That order allows respondent to pay his \$5,000 in costs due in this matter by making payment in five equal installments of \$1,000, each installment to be paid with his membership fees due in 2016, 2017, 2018, 2019, and 2020. Respondent now requests that he be allowed to begin paying the five yearly installments no earlier than the deadline for his 2017 membership dues, and continuing each year until 2021.

On July 11, 2016, the Office of Chief Trial Counsel filed a response, noting that this is respondent's third request for an extension, but nonetheless indicating that it did not oppose respondent's motion for this one year extension to begin paying his five installments after reviewing respondent's financial declaration attached to the motion.

GOOD CAUSE APPEARING, respondent's motion is GRANTED, and the court hereby MODIFIES the January 7, 2016, order, such that due dates for payment of each \$1,000 installment is changed from "2016, 2017, 2018, 2019, and 2020" to "2017, 2018, 2019, 2020, and 2021." All other aspects of the January 7, 2016, order remain in full force and effect.

IT IS SO ORDERED.


