On January 31, 2011, Respondent and the State Bar filed a stipulation for the issuance of an granting partial relief from the Supreme Court's prior order assessing costs. In that prior Supreme Court order, Respondent was ordered to pay costs in three equal installment payments, due on February 1 of the membership years 2011, 2012, and 2013. In this stipulation, the parties stipulated to this court, pursuant to Rule 5.132 of the Rules of Procedure, issuing an order extending by one year Respondent's obligation to pay the first installment of disciplinary costs, otherwise due on February 1, 2011. With that stipulated extension of time for paying the first of the previously-ordered three installment payments, Respondent's payment of the first and second installments would both be due on or before February 1, 2012; and the third installment would be due on February 1, 2013.
