On February 19, 2010, respondent **David L. Tillinger** (Respondent) filed a motion seeking to extend the one-year period of probation imposed in Supreme Court order number **S168233** as well as the time in which to comply with the order that he successfully complete the Multistate Professional Responsibility Examination (MPRE) during the probationary period. On March 1, 2010, the Office of Probation, by Terrie Goldade, filed an opposition to that motion. On March 5, 2010, Respondent filed a reply.

Respondent took the MPRE examination in November 2009, during the one-year period of his probation but failed to pass it. He then signed up to take the examination again in March 2010. Unfortunately that next session will fall outside the one-year period during which he was to take and pass the examination.

Good cause appearing and pursuant to rule 9.10(c) of the California Rules of Court and rule 550 of the Rules of Procedure of the State Bar, the court GRANTS Respondent's motion. Accordingly, the probationary period and the time in which Respondent must successfully complete the MPRE are extended until ten days until after the results of the March 2010 MPRE are released. Respondent shall provide satisfactory proof thereof to the Office of Probation no

later than 10 days after the MPRE results are received.
