TO ALL PARTIES AND COUNSEL IN THE ABOVE ENTITLED MATTER:

The court finding good cause, on its own motion, hereby modifies the Stipulation Re Facts, Conclusions of Law and Disposition and Order Approving (Stipulation), filed on January 12, 2009, as follows:

1. On page 4 of the Stipulation, under the heading "Stayed Suspension," the "X" in box "(iii)" that precedes the words "and until Respondent does the following:" is deleted. Also deleted from subparagraph "iii" are the words, "Provide proof of satisfaction of \$250 sanction imposed by Alameda County Superior Court in case number RG05210379."

2. On page 5 of the Stipulation under "E. Additional Conditions of Probation," an "X" is inserted in the box next to paragraph "(9)" and preceding the words, "The following conditions are attached hereto and incorporated." An "X" is also inserted in the box preceding the words "Financial Conditions." In addition, the following text is inserted as the incorporated and attached financial condition:

Respondent must provide proof of satisfaction of the \$250 sanction imposed by the Alameda County Superior Court in case No. RG05210379 or provide proof that said court will not accept payment of the \$250.

Any objection to these modifications must be filed within 15 days after the date of service of this order. If either party timely files an objection, the stipulation will be deemed

rejected on the date the objection is filed without necessity of further court order. If no timely objection is filed, the stipulation remains approved as modified herein, and the State Bar Court's staff is directed to transmit the record in this matter to the Supreme Court at that time without further delay.
