This matter is before the court on Richard James Stinstrom's February 12, 2014 motion for relief from orders to pay costs or, in the alternative, for an extension of time to pay the disciplinary costs that were previously imposed on him in these two nonconsolidated disciplinary proceedings. The Office of the Chief Trial Counsel of the State Bar of California opposes Stinstrom's motion for relief from the orders to pay costs, but does not oppose his alternative request for an extension of time to pay the costs.¹

Stinstrom has failed to establish sufficient hardship, special circumstances, or other good cause to grant him relief, in whole or in part, from the disciplinary costs assessed against him. Nonetheless, Stinstrom has established sufficient hardship and other good cause to grant him an extension of time to pay the costs. Accordingly, the court will extend the time in which Stinstrom must pay the costs.

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¹ Because these two proceedings are not consolidated, the court directs its case administrators to file copies of Stinstrom's motion, the State Bar's opposition, and this order in both proceedings.

ORDER

The court orders that Richard James Stinstrom's February 12, 2014, motion is GRANTED to the extent that the time in which Richard James Stinstrom must pay the costs imposed on him in (1) the Supreme Court's May 21, 2010, order in *In re Richard James Stinstrom on Discipline*, case number S181616 (State Bar Court case number 07-O-12983) and (2) the Supreme Court's May 19, 2011, order in *In re Richard James Stinstrom on Discipline*, case number S191136 (State Bar Court case number 10-N-08974) is EXTENDED as set forth below. (Bus. & Prof. Code, § 6086.10, subd. (c); Rules Proc. of State Bar, rule 5.130(B).)

Richard James Stinstrom must pay one-fifth of the outstanding and unpaid costs with his State Bar of California membership fees for each of the years 2015, 2016, 2017, 2018, and 2019. If Richard James Stinstrom fails to pay any installment as described above, or as may be hereafter modified by the State Bar Court, the remaining unpaid balance of the costs is due and payable immediately. The costs remain enforceable both as provided in Business and Professions Code section 6140.7 and as a money judgment until they are paid in full.
